What are your rights?

As a data subject, you have the right to access, rectification, erasure, restriction, objection and portability. He/she may revoke at any time any consent given furthermore has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority of the state of residence.

How can you revoke consent and file a complaint?

As a data subject, he/she may revoke at any time any consent given furthermore, he/she has the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority of the state of residence.

Which data are necessary?

The provision of **Biographical Data and Contact Data, Billing Data** is mandatory. The consequences for not providing it are: Inability to render the requested information and/or commercial offers.

What are the optional data?

The provision of data Consumption habits, Domicile and/or residence, Data provided voluntarily by the user, Bank details is optional. The consequences for not providing the data are: Inability to render more specific information or commercial offers.
